Part 1

The term „atom“ comes from the Greek word atomon , which means: the indivisible.

In this theory the atom stands for the smallest, indivisible, indestructible, permanently existing Basic element out of which any matter is made of.

A short description of the way to the smallest particle (atom):

There are many branches of development – retracing, one can see that those branches are based on some basic stages of development only. Tracing back this basic developments at some point one reaches the origin/beginning and comes to the **basic element**.

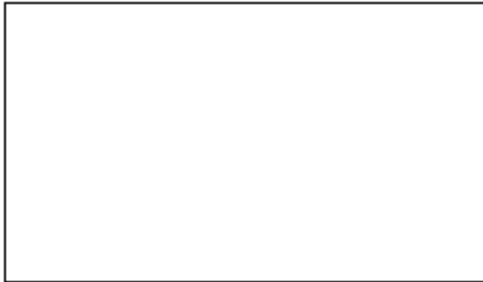
In the **basic element of all basic elements** lies the beginning of the origin and consists of the following two single components:

Nothingness

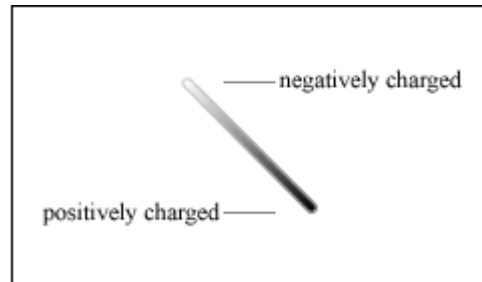
&
